Sir,


In pursuance to the directions of Hon'ble Supreme Court in its order dt- 14.9.2011, I am directed to communicate allotment of 247.555 MT of adhoc additional rice under TPDS per month meant for poorest districts which may be distributed @ 35 Kg per beneficiary @ Rs. 2/- per Kg per month identified under the above scheme.

The total number of 7073 families may be covered in the ratio of 5:8 for AAY and BPL category under the scheme in ^{three blocks of} Gajapati district at your level. The poorest families are to be covered under AAY category and rest under BPL category for record purposes. *Proposal for remaining blocks should be sent immediately.*

The allotted quantity may be lifted soon after receipt of the allotment order.

You are requested to kindly furnish lifting position of adhoc additional allocation of rice every month by the 5th of subsequent month positively in the enclosed proforma to this Department without fail.

Sub: Adhoc additional allocation under Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS) for poorest districts in States for one year -reg.

Sir,
I am directed to say that in pursuance to the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its order dated 14th September 2011 and the decision of the Central Vigilance Committee on PDS headed by Justice (Retd) D.P. Wadhwa, vide letter No. No. DR/11-37/CVC/2011 dated 23rd September, 2011, it has been decided to make adhoc additional allocation of rice and/or wheat to the 174 poorest and backward districts in twenty seven (27) States for the additional AAY and BPL families at AAY/BPL issue prices, as indicated in Annex-I.

2. The allocated foodgrains may be lifted by the States with immediate effect. The above allocation is valid for one year from the date of issue of this letter. The States may ensure distribution of 35 kg per family per month to the targeted families.

3. The State Governments are requested to separately report the lifting made by them against the abovesaid adhoc additional allocations every month by the 5th of subsequent month, positively, as per the enclosed proforma(Annex-II), to this Department.
