(1) Applications are invited from intending candidates for appointment as full time Members of Additional Bench in State Consumer Disputes Redressal Commission, Odisha, Cuttack. Those who have completed two terms as a Member in State CDR Commission are not allowed to apply under sub-section 3 of Section 16 of CP Act, 1986.

Total nos of Vacancy for the post of Members of Additional Bench in State CDR Commission- 2 (one is reserved for Judicial Member and other is non-judicial)

(2) Eligibility and disqualifications for the post of Members:-

As per S.16 (1)(b) of the Consumer Protection Act,1986 the eligibility and disqualifications of the candidates applying for the post of members are mentioned hereunder:-

Not less than two, and not more than such number of members, as may be prescribed, and one of whom shall be a woman, who shall have the following qualifications, namely:—

- (i) be not less than thirty-five years of age;
- (ii) possess a bachelor's degree from a recognized university; and
- (iii) be persons of ability, integrity and standing, and have adequate knowledge and experience of at least ten years in dealing with problems relating to economics, law, commerce, accountancy, industry, public affairs or administration:



Provided that not more than fifty percent of the members shall be from amongst persons having a judicial background.

Explanation.—For the purposes of this clause, the expression "persons having a judicial background" shall mean persons having knowledge and experience for at least a period of ten years as a presiding officer at the district level court or any tribunal at equivalent level:

Provided further that a person shall be disqualified for appointment as a member, if he—

- (a) has been convicted and sentenced to imprisonment for an offence which, in the opinion of the State Government, involves moral turpitude; or
- (b) is an undischarged insolvent; or
- (c) is of unsound mind and stands so declared by a competent court; or
- (d) has been removed or dismissed from the service of the Government or a body corporate owned or controlled by the Government; or
- (e) has, in the opinion of the State Government, such financial or other interest, as is likely to affect prejudicially the discharge by him of his functions as a member; or
- (f) has such other disqualifications as may be prescribed by the State Government.]

Applicants are advised to carefully go through the provisions of the Consumer Protection Act, 1986, Odisha Consumer Protection Rules,1988 and satisfy themselves about their eligibility for being appointed as Member, as the case may be.



(3) Terms and Condition:-

- 1. Every member of the State Commission shall hold office for a term of five years or up to the age of **sixty-seven** years, whichever is earlier:
- 2. A retired person appointed as Member on whole time basis shall receive a consolidated amount of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty thousand) inclusive of Conveyance Allowance and Telephone Charges per month over and above his pension" as per Rule 6 Sub rule 1(b) of the Orissa consumer Protection Rules,1988.
- 3. The other members of State Commission appointed on whole time basis, shall receive a honorarium amount of Rs.30,000/- (Rupees Thirty thousand) inclusive of Conveyance Allowance and Telephone Charges per month.
- (4) The members of the State Commission shall be entitled to such travelling allowance and daily allowances on official tour as are admissible to Class I officers of the State Government under the Odisha Travelling Allowance Rules as per Rule 6 Sub rule 2 of the Odisha Consumer Protection Rules, 1988.
- (5) The applications received within prescribed date shall be scrutinized and a list of the shortlisted candidates shall be prepared. Regarding short listing of the candidates the decision of the Committee of the Department is final.
