Allotment of BPL rice for Welfare Institutions under TPDS for each month of

October & November, 2013.

Sir.

In supersession to this Department letter No.15623 dt.12.09.2013 and No.18472 dt.25.10.2013 on the subject cited above, I am directed to communicate district wise break up of 175.575 MT of BPL rice under TPDS for Social Welfare Institutions i.e. Orphanages and Special Schools for each month of October & November, 2013 as per the quantity mentioned against each in the annexure enclosed. The scale of entitlement will be limited to 15 Kg. per inmate @ Rs.6.30 per Kg. The allotted rice will be lifted from own CMR. The validity period for deposit of cost and lifting of foodgrains for the month of October & November, 2013 will be upto 45 days and 50 days respectively from the date of issue of Government of India letter which was issued on 08.11.2013. The validity period for deposit of cost and lifting of foodgrains for the subsequent months from December, 2013 to March, 2014 will be as per instant instruction of the Govt.

- This allocation may be distributed only amongst the Social Welfare Institutions as per the list 2. of Institutions operated by Government Departments or by N.G.Os with grant-in-aid from Government and for the intake capacity approved by the Women & Child Development Department as per the list of institutions of the W & CD Department. All other terms and conditions are remain unaltered.
- Institutions should be given entitlement cards to enable them to draw rice. The officers of 3. concerned Department will certify utilization of stock for bonafide purpose in the card every month.
- The institutions will lift their quota from the concerned Rice Receiving Centre-cum-4. Departmental Storage Centre and they will not be asked to lift rice from F.C.I. / D.P.C. Depots. The officer in charge of RRC-cum-DSC will issue cash memo to the institutions and obtain signature.
- In case, closing stock is available with the institutions, equal quantity will be reduced from 5. the allocation for the next month.
